An IHOP will soon move into the Limelight Marketplace, the former Episcopal church turned drug-den nightclub turned retail mini-mall.

The restaurant will have outdoor seating and take up some retail space on the first floor of the Chelsea marketplace, according to Michael Ashkenazy of Ashkenazy Acquisition Corp., which owns Limelight and also manages the IHOP franchises in New York under the name TriHop.
